- **Welcome**
 - Check-in with SAC
 - We introduce ourselves
 - Approve November 7, 2022 Minutes
 - Approved by - *approved by Mike Fullerton*
- **Safety/Security Update -**
 - Parking continues to be a daily issue, especially with patrons to other local businesses
 - Dismissal continues to be an issue with unsafe driving
 - Swatting Calls was shared by Officer Howard - 14 schools in Metro Denver schools impacted by these calls.
 - Trespassing in Vehicles/Stolen vehicles has been on the uprise
 - Hyundai and Kia have been targeted for stealing..

- Parking off site will be vulnerable too.
 - Trends around drug use- fentanyl.
 - It goes in waves. Fentanyl is cheap and pill form
 - Issues in parking structure for the light rail (Lincoln Station). We have students that use the light rail. Possibly going to Park Meadows station. Possibly have smaller Link that maybe come on demand
 - Have students go to the Park Meadow Stations- safer for students (better lighting)
- **Enrollment - 135**
- **Events and Happenings**
 - ASVAB Testing March 2
 - Almost 30 kids testing
 - WorkKeys Assessment
 - We will use this for a student that struggles with assessment
 - We have CO and District will accept
 - Student will take it with Mr. Pom one on one
 - Legacy Campus Presentation - March 9
 - Presentation to our kids 4:30 and do 2 45 minute sessions.
 - What is available
 - We have 11 students who have already applied for CTE. They will be interviewed.
 - We need to make sure our kids have a fair shot at these programs
 - We have 2 kids that want to be teachers, also robotics and beauticians
 - They will go in the morning then come here at night.
 - All program by ACC
- **New to Eagle**
 - Peer Mentoring Program - Lisa
 - For student voice and creating leadership for kids
 - We have awards but not many getting Leadership Awards
 - We want to have them experience leadership skills
 - Get existing students mentoring new students
 - We have kids recommended by the teachers
 - The leadership kids will become those mentors. 4 Girls and 4 Boys. Student driven.
 - Ownership in their school and we will coach and mentor them too
 - Positive peer groups
 - Club Golf - Andrew
 - Our first sports club!

- Usually can only get PE credit online.
 - They will practice Tues/Thurs and play Friday (9 holes)
 - Family Sports Center- they will give discount (\$15 v \$27)
 - We can compete as a scrimmage event
 - After 2 years we can be CHASA
 - We have 6 kids already signed up!
 - It will start in 4th quarter

- **CTE and Concurrent Enrollment Update** - Andrew
 - We are innovating to have Concurrent classes
 - These are new to the District
 - Art Appreciation and Liberal Arts Math
 - Entertaining bringing in AP class
 - Encourages kids to see themselves as able to take college level courses

- **2023-24 Budget**
 - Was approved!!
 - No cuts to staff.
 - We have one staff person retiring. We have a need for full time Special Education Teacher
 - Not a lot of additions asked for
 - They will raise the per pupil rate for our kids
 - We keep fees for students low
 - We do pay for trips forward with current monies

- **Eagle Leadership Council**
 - Started a student council club. Students were speaking in front of the Board of Education
 - We have Scout and Braeden.
 - Want to make students feel heard. Create clubs and other activities to bring students together
 - Working on building a “Spirit Week” for class of 2023
 - Shirts and Hoodies with Eagle Pride
 - Engaging the kids to feel part of the culture.
 - First Prom coming up and they will give input for the Prom
