- **Innovation Campus - Aimee Barker**
 - Former Horticulture teacher but joined in 2011
 - 2019 CTE specialist
 - Post Secondary Readiness Coordinator
 - CTE focuses hands-on and workness ready. Must meet state approval
 - How can we increase opportunities for students to earn industry certifications and concurrent enrollment.
 - Solid Works= certificate program
 - There is a top 10 highly listed certification desired but have the least amount of trained people
 - We are in the design phase of construction. Intended open date is August '23
 - How would an Eagle student access these programs?
 - There will be 5 programs in place: Culinary (but will be an advanced programming) Aviation, Advanced Robotics & Metronics, Smart Grid Technology, Architecture and Construction.
 - How can we access it if we have not done prerequisite courses- Per Aimee, not sure yet.
 - Phase II would integrate all the pieces for construction
 - Per Claudia: How would an Eagle student be able to access these programs?
 - Per Aimee: There will be a schedule at Legacy am and pm.
 - Also, partnership with ACC. ACC can come in and run a program in the evening in our building
 - Per Jeff: 80% of our kids have jobs. What he would like, if the student is going to Legacy in the am then comes to us for an academic piece.

- Also making those school-based programs offered to our kids too.
 - Aimee says this is good feedback.
 - Per Claudia: If we could have certain seats for our kids dedicated to them
 - Per Aimee how do we better communicate with Eagle students to let them know what is offered
 - Per Claudia: Our lack of transportation, but parents would be willing to do that.
 - Per Aimee- transportation is also an equity issue too.
 - Per Aimee: Also cultivating internships and job shadowing opportunities
 - Per Jeff: CNA program?
 - Per Aimee- have one through ACC. The Legacy building does have infrastructure. EMT is in phase II
